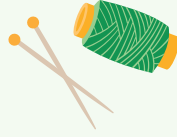


# Knit A Chick Pattern

## Materials:



- 3.25mm knitting needles
- Darning needle
- Oddments of D.K yarn
- Googly eyes or oddments of black yarn for eyes
- Red or orange felt for beak
- Ribbon or other accessories to make your chick unique

## Abbreviations:

- **K2tog** - Knit 2 stitches together
- **Inc 1 stitch** - increase one stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

## Pattern:

Cast on 26 stitches

- **Rows 1 - 4** Knit
- **Rows 5 - 20** Increase 1 st. at the beginning of each row until you have 42 sts. on needle
- **Row 21** Knit
- **Row 22** Knit
- **Row 23** Cast off 11 sts, knit to end
- **Row 24** Cast off 11 sts, knit to end
- **Rows 25-28** Increase 1 st. at beginning of row (24 sts. on needle)
- **Rows 29-32** Knit
- **Row 33** Knit 2 sts. then knit 2 tog. to last 2 sts, knit 2 (14 sts. on needle)
- **Rows 34-37** Knit
- **Row 38** Knit 2 sts. then knit 2 tog to end of row

## Fasten Off

Draw wool through remaining sts. and pull together.



## Making Up

Sew chick together down to cast on edge (leave cast on stitches as a hole to place egg in).

Stuff head with cotton wool or toy stuffing, tie yarn tight around neck and fasten off. Embroider eyes.

Cut a small diamond shape from felt to fashion a beak and sew in place.

Decorate your chick with ribbon around its' neck, a hat, a flower or anything of your choice to make it stand out.
