Complete sets of toys, games and puzzles








Furniture and upholstered items with fire regulation labels attached

Accessories like jewellery, bags, scarves and shoes

Novels, non-fiction books, and vinyl records

Items we can't re-sell



Upholstered furniture without a fire regulation label (unless pre-1950s), resealable furniture, fridges, gas and built in kitchen appliances, stair lifts, tumble dryers



Protective headgear, car seats, sharp knives, weapons, ammunition,

gas/petrol-fueled items, fireworks



Computer hard drives/laptops, food, perishables, grossly offensive materials



Soiled clothing, linens, or furniture, underwear, socks, lingerie, toys without a CE label



Medications and chemical items like cleaning products



Copyright-infringing goods, pornographic material, ivory, fur
